#### **SUPPLIES**

- Small Paper Plates
- Mirror Paper
- ✓ Tongue Depressor (Jumbo popsicle stick)
- ✓ "Thank you Hashem for making me!" (See "Printables")
- Stickers and/or crayons/ markers to decorate

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1) Take the paper plate, and cut the "mirror paper" in a circle to paste on the inside of the plate. (Don't fill the whole plate with the mirror paper; leave some space around to decorate.)
- 2) Paste on a jumbo popsicle stick (tongue depressor) to use as a holder.
- 3) Paste on the quote- "Thank you Hashem for making me!" (Or skip this step all together and just write it)
- 4) Decorate with stickers, rhinestones, markers, and crayons!

#### TUESDAY

WEEK 1 - ALL ABOUT ME

Supplies: Ball or beanbag, Dry-erase markers and white board



#### Overview of Learning:

Discuss how Hashem created us. We are all special and different. We are not just who we look like on the outside, but what is most important is who we are on the inside. Ask the children for different ways that we can be beautiful on the inside (give to others, play with friends, choose nice words, be patient etc.). Every Jewish person has a Neshama (a spark of Hashem) that connects us to each other. Our Neshama gives us life!



#### **Activity:**

- 1. Pass around the small ball or beanbag to each child and give them a turn to say something about themselves (choose a topic-favorite color, animal, or activity).
- 2. Extra for age 3+: Draw a graph of different things like blue eyes, brown eyes, long hair, short hair, and have each child come up and choose which they have on the graph.
